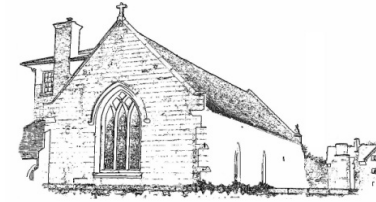

This review is being conducted by an independent charity called **SCIE** (Social Care Institute for Excellence).
