Find all the words in the word list. Words are hidden in straight lines, going frontwards, backwards and diagonally.

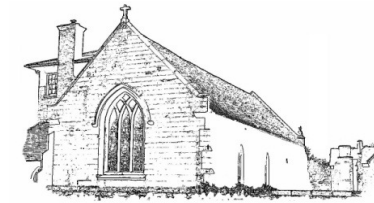
