This review is to be welcomed as a means of ensuring that our systems to protect our children and young people are as effective as possible. This review is being conducted by an independent charity called **SCIE** (Social Care Institute for Excellence). As part of the review, SCIE would like to speak with any individuals who have had experience with any safeguarding issues within the Archdiocese and have experience of working with our parish safeguarding representatives and the safeguarding team at the Archdiocese. 

We need to make sure that you or your friend or family member have consented to their name being published on that list. This is because the list can be seen by a lot of people as it is put up on the noticeboard at the back of church, is available for anyone to pick up in church and is also published on the internet through the parish website. From now onwards the written list will only mention the names of all for whom the parish have consent. This is necessary to make sure the church takes proper care of your information and complies with current data protection law. There are also blank letters available (on the notice board and the table) to offer to anyone who may want prayers, visits or any other support from the parish whilst they are not well.
