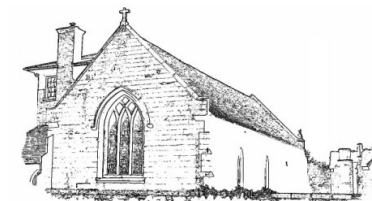

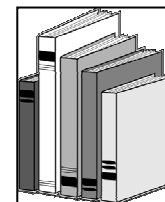
FIRST HOLY COMMUNION at St Mary's 3 June 2018
