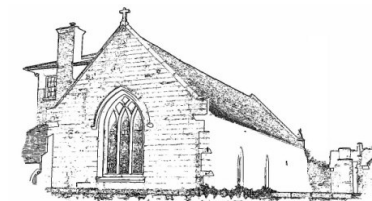




THE ANGELUS

Do you perhaps recognize the picture above? It's a famous painting about a famous prayer: the Angelus! In this 19th century work by the French painter Jean-Francois Millet, a farming couple prays the Angelus at dusk. [The Angelus reminds us of **THE ANNUNCIATION**]. This prayer is well suited to the artist's subject matter: two humble people paying homage to our Lord and His Blessed Mother in the Hail Mary, as well as in Gospel verses recalling His Incarnation as the Word entered the World. Its name comes from its opening words in Latin, "Angelus Domini nuntiavit Mariæ."
